The Department of Materials Science and Engineering at Cornell University is soliciting applications for a full-time, renewable non-tenure track Lecturer/Senior Lecturer. Self-standing laboratory courses and laboratory modules integrated with lecture courses are essential elements of the rigorous curriculum of the MSE undergraduate program. We are seeking exceptional candidates who can teach existing laboratory courses, in particular [Junior Laboratory I](#) and [II](#), and develop new laboratory courses and modules associated with courses from the freshman to the senior undergraduate level. Opportunities within the position include pursuing scholarship on laboratory instructional pedagogy as well as initiating teaching collaborations with MSE faculty.

The MSE Department and the College of Engineering at Cornell embrace diversity and seek candidates who will create a climate that attracts students of all races, nationalities and genders. People from historically underrepresented groups are strongly encouraged to apply.

By August 2022 candidates should have been granted a PhD in materials science and engineering or in a related field such as chemistry, physics, or an engineering discipline involving mechanical, electrical, chemical, or biological materials. Candidates must demonstrate a commitment to teaching excellence, familiarity with the pedagogy of laboratory instruction, and facility with designing and operating scientific apparatus.
