Candidates should have a demonstrated ability to conduct high-impact research that will broaden the discipline and reflects the future of the field. Candidates are sought who pursue materials research and engineering to solve some of the world's most difficult energy, climate, health, computing, and communication challenges. The successful candidate will be responsible for carrying out research, teaching, and service while building a vibrant research program that contributes to the department's mission and is committed to supporting diversity, equity, and a community of inclusion. The MSE Department is dedicated to building a diverse community and strongly encourage applications from underrepresented groups. Qualified international applicants are also welcome.

Applicants should hold a PhD in Materials Science and Engineering, Physics, Chemistry, Chemical Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, or a related field by the time of appointment. Applicants must apply online and upload the following materials: cover letter; curriculum vita; research statement; teaching experience and mentoring statement; contribution to diversity, equity and inclusion statement; contribution to department vision statement; and three letters of recommendation. Evaluation of applications will begin November 19, 2021 and continue until the positions are filled.
